## Paper Chain Prayers

This is a way for each child to help us pray for each other.  
 Give each child a piece of paper to make a paper chain.  
 Encourage them to write their name on the paper and draw a picture like  
 see the example.  
 Then place all the pieces in the middle.  
 Each child takes a piece and says a prayer for the child whose name is on the paper.  
 Then wrap them all together to form a chain.  
 We can hold the chain together as a group and say big prayers together.  
 This can be placed somewhere that we can keep adding to it over the coming weeks.  
 If there is a child in the group who is smaller than the others, they can be the first to say a prayer for the group.
